Note: Temporary or Starter Checks are not accepted for any transaction.

- 1 – Acceptable debit/credit cards: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Amex, prepaid cards with Visa, MasterCard or Amex Logo.
- 2 – Personal checks not accepted if case referred to a collection agency, payee has prior NSF, or for non-case receipting.
- 3 – Business checks not accepted unless from an attorney, bond company, insurance company or at management's discretion.
- 4 – Traveler's Checks not accepted unless manager approves for a special circumstance.
- 5 – Personal Checks not accepted if ordered to pay directly to the State Child Support Unit or payee has prior NSF.
- 6 – Business Checks not accepted for Foreclosure Final Sales payment unless from an Attorneys Trust Account.
- 7 – Debit/Credit cards are not accepted for payment of rent on eviction cases or for foreclosure sale bids.
- 8 – Business Checks not accepted unless from an Attorney's Trust Account.
- 9 – Money Orders are accepted when received from the Jail or the Osceola County Sheriff's Office.
